09-004A	Playground Sidewalk to Manor View Elementary from Potomac Place Neighborhood	Construct a walking path from Potomac Place Neighborhood to Manor View Elementary.	Community Support	FMWR/CYSS	Project has been funded and is in the DPW queue. School Liasion will partner with DPW and Housing to resolve this issue. Picerne is POC for action regarding stairs at this location. Continue to monitor this issue.	Active
09-004B	Manor View Elementary Cross Walks	Place crossing guards at all intersections in Manor View Elementary school zones.	Community Support	FMWR/CYSS	After reviewing the request it was decided that there is sufficient coverage already in place and a second crossing guard is not warranted at this time. Increasing safety measures at all intersections were discussed (stop signs with LED lights in lieu of 2nd crossing guard, standing barriers or traffic cones). Report from Safety Officer forthcoming. 09-005	Prescription Pick Up	Establish a FGGM KACC satellite drive-through pick-up pharmacy at the PX/Commissary with hours comparable to these facilities.	Family Support	MEDDAC/DPW	Per DeCA Facilities Construction Division, putting a satellite pharmacy at the Commissary would require approval from DeCA Headquarters. A request is being forwarded to HQ DeCA for staffing. No update from AAFES regarding this issue. KACC will provide an information paper supporting need for a satellite pharmacy.	Active

09-006	Internal Transportation System	Establish a contract to provide an affordable, rider-funded and handicapped accessible FGGM community shuttle bus.	Community Support	DOL	The Strategic Transition Work Group has an initiative to give to the commander regarding the cost to the installation to operate a continual shuttle bus in addition to current operational DINFOS shuttle. This is still in the information gathering stage, and there will be a meeting to brainstorm ideas for submission.	Active
09-009A	Trash Removal in Housing Areas	Increase the frequency of trash removal by one additional visit per week. Authorize system of monitoring (i.e., cameras) in each recycle/compactor area.	Housing	RCI/Picerne	"Close to Full" alarms are now on the 3 compactors at Meuse Forest (if it is close to full the vendor is called to come pick up the compactor to empty). Compactors are inspected several times per day to ensure cleanliness of area. Every year consideration is given to re-design/renovate additional compactor stations. The first compactor station remodel is near completion for the first (Phelps Drive next to the NHC) of two Potomac Place compactor stations, with the second scheduled in 2010 as well.	Active
09-009B	Housing Recycling Program	Standardize recycling throughout FGGM housing areas.	Housing	RCI/Picerne	Evaluating available options for larger recycle containers for residents with curb side service; RCI is involved with this evaluation (including budget constraints). A recycling area (similar to what is in place at Heritage Park) will be included in the re-design of the compactor stations.	Active
09-010	Child Safety Restraints on Commissary Shopping Carts	Replace or repair the restraints on all FGGM Commissary shopping carts on a recurring basis, so that all parents have access to "safe" carts.	Community Support	DeCA	Identified as a continual problem. DeCA has a non-dedicated employee who repairs the restraints overnight, but with increased public use, this is becoming a constant repair/replace issue. Until a better solution is attained, DeCA will continue to proceed with the overnight repair system. Safety officer to make inspection visit and report back to committee.	Active

09-011	Dedicated Bike Lane on FGGM	Create bike lanes on Mapes, Cooper and Rockenbach roads as part of the BRAC strategic plan.	Community Support	DPW	DPW has contacted the architects for this project; bike lanes will be part of the circulation plan for the installation. Costs needs to be determined.	Active
09-019	Off-leash Dog Park at FGGM for Community Dog Owners	Designate an enclosed arear for off-leash dogs to run and play safely.	Community Support	DPW	Project has been funded and location has been secured near CDC III off of Ernie Pyle Road.	Active
09-026	On Post Housing Availability Outside Pay Grade	Authorize exception to policy to allow SM to accept housing outside pay grade if appropriate quarters are unavailable. Require signed waiver stating resident will accept lower grade housing for duration of duty assignment.	Housing	RCI/Picerne	The exception to policy will be considered on a case by case basis to receive housing outside a pay grade if appropriate quarters are available. Waiver is required to be signed. There is no waiting list for housing at this time. Issue voted to be closed.	Closed
