

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CYS SUMMER CAMP

What do I need to bring with me to my scheduled registration appointment?

You will need to bring the following items: the completed packet, as mentioned above, which will include; Child Care Fee Application, CYS Registration Form, Child Release Designee Form, Sponsor Consent Form, Proof of Single Parent Status Form, USDA Form, Health Assessment Form, Family Care Plan & Special Needs Form and Mission Essential Personnel Form. You will also need to bring a Military or DoD/NSA civilian ID card, a current LES statement or pay stub for both spouses (to include retirement & second jobs), proof of age for your child (ID card, birth certificate or passport) and current shot record.

****If you fail to bring any of the above documentation (completed) or are late for your registration appointment, YOUR APPOINTMENT WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CANCELLED AND RESCHEDULED.**

What is Summer Camp and what type of activities are planned for this summer?

The School-Age and MS Summer Camp is a place for your child to spend part of their summer vacation in a safe and fun environment. Ten fun filled weeks of activities are planned to include arts and crafts, specialty camps, swimming, competitive & non-competitive games, field trips, computer lab, enrichment activities, special events and visiting performers. Can medication be administered to my child?

CYS staff are trained in administering medication procedures. CYS needs to be notified upon registration if your child has any special needs. Certain medications must be approved by the Community Health Nurse prior to Summer Camp. Please notify CYS staff immediately should your child need medication to be administered during Summer Camp.

WHAT SHOULD YOUR CHILD BRING TO CAMP?

- Bathing suit, towel and sun screen on swimming days.
- A tote bag/backpack labeled with child's name for clothing changes.

WHAT SHOULD YOUR CHILD LEAVE AT HOME?

- Opened toed shoes and sandals (these are unsafe for outdoor activities)
- MONEY (except on field trips)
- ALL TOYS FROM HOME
- ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES (RADIOS/CD PLAYERS/VIDEO GAMES)

What meals are provided for child(ren)?

Breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack will be provided daily.
